Case #2015-005

Respondents: Security Engineers, Inc.

Disposition: Respondent violated Ala. Code §§ 34-27C-4(a) and 34-27C-7(a), for failing to register and license some employees. Respondent entered into a consent agreement with the Board regarding the alleged violations. Pursuant to the consent agreement, Respondent was fined \$25,000.00 and placed on probation for two years. The fine has been paid in full.

It was further ordered that the licenses of both Respondents be suspended for two years.
